

Southside Community Land Trust Community Garden Rules

- 1. Gardeners must attend 2 workdays every year.**
 - On workdays, gardeners work together in common spaces, not in their own plots.
 - Everyone must arrive on time, and stay for the garden meeting at the end of the work session.
- 2. Keep the garden clean.**
 - Pick up trash and bring it home.
 - Keep paths clear; no planting in paths.
 - Pick up trash around the perimeter of the fence.
- 3. No Chemicals are allowed in the garden. No Miracle Grow allowed!**
 - Only organic fertilizer like compost, fish emulsion, and aged manure are allowed.

- 4. Plant in your plot, only.**
 - If you have questions about where your plot is, ask your garden's Garden Leader.
- 5. Gardeners cannot give their plot away.**
 - If you decide to leave your plot, you must tell your Garden Leader. They will look at the waitlist and assign the plot.
- 6. Save water.**
 - Turn off water spigot completely when you finish watering.
 - No storing water in buckets or open containers, as it attracts insects.
- 7. Lock garden gate when you leave.**
- 8. Take enough compost to cover one (1) inch deep in your plot.**
 - The compost is for everyone in the garden to share equally.
- 9. Clean your plot for winter.**
- 10. Pay plot fee and sign a contract each year.**
 - If you move, give your garden leader your new address and phone number.
- 11. Gardeners must plant their plot by June 15.**
 - If it's not planted, the plot will be given to the next person on the waitlist.
