


Trailhead Signs

Purpose

For the identification of public entrances and trailheads. Trailhead or kiosk signs come in different forms depending on the setting, complexity, and information needs.

Installation

Install where needed communicate general information and behavioral and advisory rules and expectations. These signs or kiosks may also be installed on posts with other existing or proposed signs, for example, those providing directions into a project.



Consider installing signs where needed in the special areas of concern. Advisory signs must follow local and RI DEM regulations for proper placement and spacing of signs (i.e. No Hunting, Trespassing, etc.).
