


Definitions

stewardship



1: the careful and responsible management of something entrusted to one's care

Examples: forest management, invasive control, easement monitoring, public access, legal protection....

CSC Mission

The Conservation Stewardship Collaborative (CSC) works to advance long-term protection and stewardship of terrestrial, aquatic, coastal, estuarine, and marine areas in Rhode Island that have been conserved by fee, easement, or other means.

What does the CSC ...

... do?


- Promotes efficiency through cooperation and collaboration
- Promotes better stewardship through data sharing
- Promotes better protection of land and easement records, stronger legal standing of properties, and appropriate use of protected lands
 - Training and development of standards

... not do?

- Give grants
- Have a staff
- Create a new institutional entity
- Compete with other conservation organizations
- Address issues of developed recreational open space (ball fields, golf courses, etc.)

Why Do We Need to Work Together

- Our network of protected lands is complex
- Threats can appear suddenly and spread
