

Geocache Conditions

1. A Geocache Placement Permit Application must be completed and approved by the appropriate Corps of Engineers (COE) office before posting the cache on a geocaching website. The fee for a special use permit is waived.
2. Only containers marked with "Geocache" may be used as caches. No digging or excavation is permitted.
3. COE permits will not be issued on property held in flowage easement.
4. Permit is good for one year from date permit issue. After that date the cache must be re-permitted or removed. It is possible that a longer term be granted after the first year of the permit. If the cache owner removes the cache prior to the expiration date, they will notify the Park Manager immediately (203.729.8840).
5. The COE reserves the right to terminate this permit for placement of a Geocache on Corps land for any reason at any time. Caches not in compliance with the terms of this permit will be removed from the property and this permit is voided for failure to comply.
6. Cache owner shall monitor this cache every 2 months to insure it is family friendly. This means that the cache will not contain food, alcohol, firearms, drugs, dangerous items, or pornographic material.
7. Only the COE Park Manager or their designee can approve of the cache site.
8. All federal, state and local laws apply to caches and related activities.
9. The name of the cache and the website address will be provided within 7 days of placement to the COE.
10. Unauthorized caches on COE lands will be removed and the responsible party may be cited under the Federal Code of Regulations, Title 36, Part 327.
11. All activity and authorized caches are subject to Federal Code of Regulations, Title 36, Part 327.
12. Cache permittees shall delete website location(s) from all records within seven days of removal of cache.
13. User fees will apply to all participants during the designated recreation season from the weekend before Memorial Day weekend, through the weekend after Labor Day, and will not be waived as a condition of this permit. User fees will not apply to the Geocache OWNER as related to the duties of monitoring and maintaining the geocache box.
