










Be a Part of the Local Planning Process



Land Use Act



The Act requires comp plans to contain certain minimum content pertaining to conservation and natural resources including:

- A map or maps displaying open space and conservation areas (public and private) § 45-22.2-6(b)(2)
- A map or maps displaying natural resources such as, but not limited to, surface water, wetlands, floodplains, soils, and agricultural land § 45-22.2-6(b)(2)


Process

Process through which a Board or Commission conducts the public's business

- Some procedures are mandated e.g. type of notice, when a public hearing is required
- Some procedures are at the discretion of the Board or Commission conduct of business and "protocols".

To contribute in a manner that is effective – an advocate needs to be familiar with the process.

Your Position as Advocate



Be Prepared

Start with public record. (project background, resources, stage or review, staff opinion)
Build your own knowledge. (research subject parcel, applicant and the proposed use)
Understand your role in the process.

Standards of Review

Burden is on the applicant to prove that all the standards have been met Lobbyists and hired consultants subjective Advocate for a more reasonable alternative and mitigation of impacts Officials must give thoughtful consideration to all information presented.

- Water Table
- LID GI
- No Net Increase in Runoff
- 100 Year Storm
- GPOD/Overlay
